



A high yielding, dual purpose, feed quality barley for early sowing.

- An alternate to the traditional grazing cereals—triticale, wheat and oats
- True winter habit with a cold requirement for head initiation
- Excellent plant stature with good straw strength
- Resistant to leaf scald, net form of net blotch and barley grass stripe rust

Urambie[®] is a two-row, semi-dwarf, feed barley, with unique adaptability to early sowing due to it's winter habit. It has early maturity combined with a cold requirement for initiation of heading, and a sowing window from early-March to mid-May in NSW.

Urambie[®] is higher yielding than Tantangara (feed) and Gairdner[®] (malt) grazed or ungrazed. It offers an alternative to Binalong in northern NSW with comparable yield but with difference in disease resistance.

Features

- Resistant to both leaf scald and net form of net blotch in southern NSW. It is also resistant to barley grass stripe rust.
- A seed fungicide dressing should be used to give early suppression of powdery mildew, smuts and some strains of scald.
- Seed size greater than Tantangara.
